In 1861 case to Jamesville Iowa. Was married Feb. 16 1868 at Jamesville to Margaret Wallace by whom he had 5 children. She was born in Antrina Ireland June 28 1845. She died at Jamesville, Iowa on Oct. 22, 1905. In 1907 he was married to Mrs. Florence Schayler Jones, who after his death moved to Delecon Wos.

Mr. Ballanyne served as mayor of Jamesville Iowa and served other positions of trust.
