Came to Jamesville Ia. in 1849. His father laid out the town of Jamesville Ia. and named it for his wife Jane.

He was born in Ohio and enlisted from Jamesville Ia. at age of 27 Promoted 5 Corp. Jan 1 1864. Transferred to Co 1 34 & 38 Consolidated Btn. Jan 1 1865. He was made 3rd Cpl. July 1 1865 and discharged at Houston Texas, and Co. dismantled at Davenport Ia.

The wife Elizabeth died at Finchford Ia. three miles west of Jamesville on Oct. 23 1906, age 73.
