Born in Pittsford Rutland Co. Vt. In 1818 came to Wankesha Co. Wis.
In 1854 and following year of Aug 1855 to Bremer Co. Ia. He lived in
Franklin township. He was an early day surveyor of Bremer Co. and did
work also in Butler Co. Ia. He enlisted from Shell Rock and attached
to the unit which was absorbed by the engineers later to be known as
the Engineers of the West of Mo. Unit. After the war he was Co. Sur
veyor for a time. Was discharged for wounds at Vicksburg Miss. An
brother W. W. Beal lived at Waverly for many years.

When Dexter Beal died he was buried in Grove Hill Cemetary near the
first home of the family in Bremer County, 4 miles East of Readlyn, Ia.
Iowa index shows this man but does not give his regiment or Co. Found
some in Volumn 6 page 144 of Iowa Soldiers.
