Born at Little Utica near Baldromville Onandago Co. New York. Oct. 18 1820. Came for a short period to state of Wis and in 1870 to Horton, Ia where he farmed until death. The family continued to live on same farm from 1870 to 1899. He married Emily Gifford in New York Dec. 2, 1847 came to Bremer Co. in 1870.

Enlisting in 1861 from Baldromville New York in Co A. 185 N. Y. Inf. was wounded in battle of the Wilderness from scalp wound he drew pension in later life. His hearing was imparied also from cannistry firing over their heads. s veterenized 1864. To them were born six children.
