Born in the U. S. state of N. Y. in 1833 he received a common school education and later the trade of wagon maker. When he was wounded in service he never fully recovered. Returning to his home in N. Y. and the following year of 1866 came to Bremer Co. Iowa settling at Horton. He was married at N. Y. to Sarah J. Maxam in 7-4-1857 and to tem were born 3 children, Carrie, Hattie and Frank. He lived near Horton coming here 1866 for over 35 years conducting a wagon making shop. Mrs. Potter was born in Franklin Co., New York 12-10-1838 and died at Horton, Iowa 12-3-1906. Warren and Marion, 2 sepaarate men. Warren was 1 St. Marion burried in Nashua, Iowa he was the Captain --- they were brothers.
