Born in Steubenville Jefferson Co. Ohio Nov. 13, 1840 and 2nd. son of John R. and Marg't Moore Abraham they both died in 1853.

Co. B 7th. Ohio Vo.. Inf. and served three months reenlisted in the 103 Ohio Inf. ~~as a~~ as a 2nd. Corp. and served until the end of the war having 34 months of service. He was married twice. He came to Bremer Co. in 1865 was a member of L.O.O.F. Lodge

He took part in the battle of Blue Springs Knoxville Resaca Kenesaw Mountain Spring hill, Tenn. and the siege of Atlanta Dandridge.

1st. enlistment in April 1861 served 3 month was discharged. 2nd. enlistment was as Corp. in 103 Ohio Inf. Aug. 14, 1862 in Co. A. mustered in at Ft. Thom Ky. disch. at Raleigh NC June 12, 1865 a daughter by first marriage Mrs. Mary Elizabeth Woodmansee lives in Cleveland Oh by the 2nd marriage to Lucy Crosier Dec. 3, 1865 Mrs. A survived her husband but a few months.

Came to Waverly in 1865

Vocation farmer retired and moved to Waverly where he died.

He was the 2nd. child of the family came to Ia. in the fall of 1865

His 2nd. wife Lucy Corsier was a dau of Luther C. Corsier his father Jason Corsier a soldier of 1812.
