H. H. Shepard Abstract Co., in 70th Year

The Shepard Abstract company, 205 Foresters' building, began its 70th year Saturday, with Hugh H. Shepard, son of the founder of the company, in charge.

The same advertisement, in condensed form and without any date, appeared in the Mason City Globe-Gazette, published by George J. Fox, editor, Wednesday, Oct. 2, 1875.

This record has been made public by the appreciation and patriotism of friends and relatives through the years, according to Mr. Shepard.

Hugh H. Shepard, father of Hugh H. Shepard, established the office when in Jan. 1, 1875, he became the first official recorder of Cerro Gordo county.

On April 29, 1877, Hugh H. Shepard made his first abstract, which was written long hand on wooden form supplied by the county auditor.

In February, 1925, Shepard began his farm loan business, and in 1926, the Shepard Abstract Co. was incorporated with capital stock of \$25,000.
