Wayne R. Hartman, 76, of Janesville, Iowa, died on Wednesday, March 16, 2016, at Covenant Medical Center, in Waterloo, Iowa.

Wayne was born on May 7, 1939, in Waverly, Iowa, the son of John and Pauline (Voigts) Hartman. He was raised on a farm near Allison, Iowa, and attended country school. In 1957, he graduated from Allison High School. On October 2, 1959, Wayne was united in marriage to Diane Poppe in Vilmar, Iowa. The couple divorced, and later she became his best friend. On March 8, 1962, Wayne entered the United States Army; he was honorably discharged on March 6, 1964. Wayne enjoyed his career as a carpenter and foreman. Wayne was a member of Messiah Lutheran Church, Janesville American Legion Post #522, and Lions Club International. He was a sports fan and in his younger years played baseball. Later he enjoyed bowling, playing fast-pitch softball, and fishing.
