### **Obituary**

Roger James Henninger, 73, of Waverly, Iowa, died early Wednesday morning, December 16, 2015 at the Lutheran Home in Strawberry Point, Iowa.

Roger was born on February 24, 1942, in Waverly, Iowa, the son of Claude and Rose (Hill) Henninger. He was baptized on March 28, 1942, and later confirmed at St. John Lutheran Church in Waverly. He grew up in Waverly and attended the Waverly-Shell Rock School district. As a teenager, he worked at the Waverly Bowl Inn and enjoyed roller skating. He entered the United States Marine Corps on July 22, 1960, and was honorably discharged in 1964. Following his military discharge, Roger worked for Terex Cranes from 1967, until his retirement in 1999. He also worked for Crystal Heating and Plumbing.

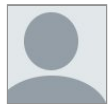
