

Rudolph E. "Rudy" Kohagen

March 6, 1933 - January 20, 2018

Rudolph E. "Rudy" Kohagen, 84, of Cedar Falls, died at home on Saturday, January 20, 2018.

He was born March 6, 1933 in Waverly, Iowa, the son of Rudolph W. and Amanda (Milius) Kohagen.

Rudy married Marilyn Meier on October 12, 1958 at St. John Lutheran Church (Maxfield) near Denver, Iowa.

Rudy was a 1951 graduate of Tripoli High School and served in the U.S. Air Force during the Korean Conflict from February 1953-December 1956.

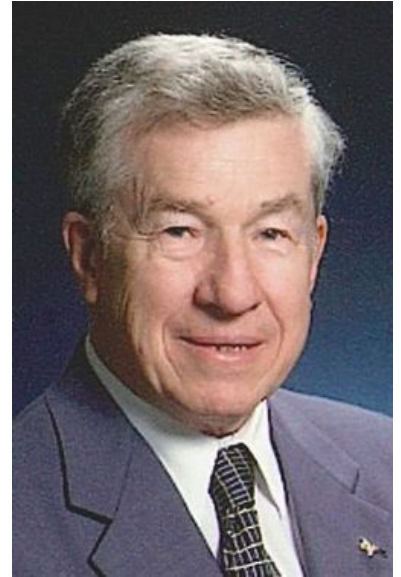
