John J. "Junior" Boeck, 94, of Waverly, and formerly of Janesville, Iowa, died on Sunday, August 12, 2018, at his home in Waverly.

John was born on May 2, 1924, in Irma, Iowa, the son of John Otto and Mervil (Adams) Boeck. He graduated from Janesville High School in 1942 and attended Wartburg College. He served in the United States Marines during World War II and was honorably discharged on July 12, 1946. He worked at John Deere in the Product Engineering Center and later drove school bus for the Janesville Schools.
